82 SFX: THEY APPROACH.

83 HARTICA: My love -- are you in pain?

84 HEROICON: Not when I'm in your arms, Hartica. Not when I can see your

face.

85 BERNICE: And -- smile --

86 HARTICA: (HISSED) Mum, you're ruining the moment.

87 SAMANTHA: Are they -- taking photos?

88 JARNGLE: Ah, brilliant. You must be here to rescue us.

89 BERNICE: Thank Bruce, it's getting chilly down here!

118 SFX: KILNER AND THE CAPTAIN ENTER THE

ENGINE ROOM. BEEPING, FLASHING LIGHTS.

ALARMS AND SO ON.

119 KILNER: Okay! So this is what we're working with --

120 CAPTAIN: What are you doing?

121 KILNER: This looks pretty salvageable... We just need to shut off the

damaged rooms. Looks like -- yep, level three's been fully

evacuated, we can seal that off...

122 CAPTAIN: Uh --

123 KILNER: Well, go on then.

124 CAPTAIN: What?

125 KILNER: Type in the code.

126 CAPTAIN: The what?

127 KILNER: The captain's confirmation code. So we can save the ship.

Come on!

128 SFX: AN ALARM BEEPS ON THE CAPTAIN'S WATCH.

129 CAPTAIN: Uh --

130 KILNER: What was that?
