3 SFX: MUSIC ENDS

SCENE 1 - INT. YELLOW SUB - DAY

4 KILNER: So we've been waiting for — three days, now?

5 SAMANTHA: The cryo pods must have woken us up for a reason.

6 KILNER: Any updates, DAX?

7 DAX: Hmm, updates... Well, this is what I've been

listening to these last three days...

8 SFX: TERRIBLE HOLD MUSIC

9 AUTOMNIVOICE: You have ONE mission pending. Please hold the

line for instructions. You have ONE mission

pending.

10 KILNER: Great if they actually... told us what it was.

11 SAMANTHA: [SIGHS]

12 DAX: I can try and send an override signal I suppose.

Ping the database and try and force the brief

through?

13 KILNER: It's worth a shot.

14 SFX: DAX SENDS THROUGH AN

OVERRIDE SIGNAL.

15	DAX:	And here we go
16	SFX:	AUTOMNICON MISSION MUSIC STARTS.
17	AUTOMNIVOICE:	You will be WAITING FOR a MISSION PENDING.
18	KILNER:	Seriously?
19	DAX:	Wait, there's actually something coming in now.
20	SAMANTHA:	And it's definitely something?
21	DAX:	I know exactly as much as you do.
22	KILNER:	Helpful.
23	SFX:	AUTOMNICON MISSION MUSIC PLAYS.
24	AUTOMNIVOICE:	You will be TRANSPORTING the PRINCESS NATALIS from THE PLANET ARBORITA ONE to THE PLANET ARBORITA TEN. Additional Notes: PENDING.
27	DAX:	Interesting. The Arboritans are a fairly recently discovered race. Plant based beings.
28	KILNER:	Like —
29	DAX:	No, not like that. These are benign. They're, uh. Basically trees.
30	KILNER:	And we're taking one from Arborita One to Arborita Ten?
31	DAX:	Yes. It's part of a tradition in their solar system to diversify their species. Every five years (well, every thirteen point five Arboritan Grent Cycles, but in our terms that's about five years) there's an uprooting - a big gathering of the younger royal trees from each of the planets. Then there's a big party that lasts — about five years. And then they do it again with

another set.

32 SAMANTHA: It lasts five years?!

33 DAX: Well, they are trees. Time's different for them.

34 SAMANTHA: Oh. Right.

35 KILNER: We're not — going to be waiting around to pick

them up, are we?

36 DAX: No. One particular — quirk of this festival is that the

majority of those attending, uh. Stay there.

37 KILNER: What, really?

40 DAX: I've set a course for the Arboritan System.

41 KILNER: Thanks.

42 SAMANTHA: So... another round of Cluedo?

43a KILNER: No. I'm good.

43b DAX: Festive Cluedo?

43c KILNER: No, putting little hats on the pieces doesn't make it

more interesting. And they keep falling off.

43d DAX: Suit yourself.

SCENE 2 - INT. YELLOW SUB - LATER

45 SFX: THE YELLOW SUB APPROACHES

ARBORITA ONE.

46 KILNER: Is there — anywhere to land? It looks like just...

thick trees. Everywhere.

47 DAX: These are the coordinates in the file... I guess I'll

get in touch and see what they say.

48 SAMANTHA: Oh. Oh, that's weird.

49 KILNER: What?

50 SAMANTHA: Look at the trees! They're moving!

51 KILNER: They're shuffling out of the way!

52 DAX: Well, I guess I'll land, then.

53 SFX: THE YELLOW SUB LANDS.

54 DAX: I'll send out a message and let them know you're

here. Although they all — seem to be aware

already.

55 KILNER: Okay. I guess we'll... go out onto the planet.

56 SFX: THE RAMP OPENS AND THEY WALK

DOWN IT.

SCENE 3 - EXT. PLANET - DAY

57 SFX: KILNER AND SAMANTHA BOTH

BREATHE DEEPLY. THE AIR IS RICH

AND WHOLESOME.

58 SAMANTHA: Oh Bruce, the air.

59 KILNER: I know.

60 SAMANTHA: It's beautiful. I didn't know I could -- enjoy breathing

this much.

61 NATALIS: Um... hello?

62 SAMANTHA: Oh! Hi. Uh. We didn't see you there.

63	NATALIS:	Yes, sorry. I do blend in a bit. Um. That's always been a problem. Anyway. Um. I think you're looking for me? I'm Princess Natalis.
64	KILNER:	We are! Sorry, we're new to this — area. So you're a princess? How does that work with - trees?
65	NATALIS:	Princess isn't really the word for it, but it's probably the closest word you have.
66	KILNER:	So do we — uh. You're in a pot. How do we —
67	SFX:	WHIRRING AND LITTLE FOOTSTEPS
68	KILNER:	Ah. You're in a pot with — hundreds of little legs.
69	NATALIS:	Of course. It's how we move about. We don't just plant ourselves under the nearest parent any more. We get to pick where we go.
70	SAMANTHA:	That explains a lot!
		[YELPS] What's that?
70b	NATALIS:	Sorry, that's my luggage.
71	KILNER:	Same little legs. Cool.
		Um — would you like to come on board?
72	NATALIS:	Yes. Thank you.
73	SFX:	SHE CLIMBS UP THE RAMP.
74	DAX:	Hello.
75	NATALIS:	Hi. I'm Natalis. (SHE TURNS BACK) Aren't you coming inside?
76	SAMANTHA:	Sorry, we're just — enjoying the air.
77	NATALIS:	Alright. Uh. I can wait.

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78	SFX:	PRINCESS NATALIS ENTERS. KILNER AND SAMANTHA REMAIN OUTSIDE
79	DAX:	Well, Welcome on board, Princess Natalis.
80	NATALIS:	Thank you. I'm a bit nervous. I've never been on a spaceship before. It's very strange to be so far away from the ground.
81	DAX:	We'll try and make it a nice journey. And it's a short one, at least.
82	SFX:	KILNER AND SAMANTHA ENTER, GIDDY WITH OXYGEN. THE DOOR CLOSES BEHIND THEM.
83	DAX:	Ready to go?
84	KILNER:	Yes. Sorry. Just haven't breathed that well in a while.
85	NATALIS:	That does tend to happen to oxygen-breathing life forms when they visit. Sorry, it should probably have been mentioned.
86	DAX:	I'll start takeoff procedures, then.
87	SFX:	THE YELLOW SUB'S ENGINE STARTS UP.
88	SAMANTHA:	So are you — ready?
89	NATALIS:	To leave my homeland forever for somewhere I've never been?
90	SAMANTHA:	Uh. I meant for the party.
91	NATALIS:	Oh. Um. No. To either question.
92	SAMANTHA:	Oh.

93	NATALIS:	It's — fine. I'll be alright. I've been waiting for this since I was a seedling. It's just — a strange thing, is all. I'm quite nervous.
94	KILNER:	So what's the worst that could happen?
95	NATALIS:	All of my needles could fall off.
96	KILNER:	Ah.
97	SAMANTHA:	Is that likely?
98	NATALIS:	It could happen! And it would be really embarrassing!
99	SFX:	SHE TAKES A DEEP BREATH.
100	NATALIS:	Sorry. I'm catastrophizing. I know. This is just an important time in my life and I want to get it right.
101	SAMANTHA:	Oh, I completely get it. We had these coming out balls when I was younger and it was so important that everything was perfect. And if it wasn't you knew you'd be excluded from popular society forever.
102	NATALIS:	Forever? Oh, no
103	KILNER:	I'm not sure that helped.
104	SAMANTHA:	I mean our - societies are very different. I'm sure that everything will be fine.
105	NATALIS:	Yes. It it'll all be fine.
106	SFX:	NATALIS TAKES ANOTHER DEEP BREATH.
107	NATALIS:	Okay, I'm ready to start the decorating.
108	KILNER:	The what?
400	NIATALIO	Lead decrees

I need decorations.

SCENE 5 - INT. YELLOW SUB - LATER

120 SAMANTHA: Okay, so... I couldn't get any real tinsel, but

unravelled copper wire does have a similar effect.

That was a good thought.

121 KILNER: It's not like we were using that light fitting anyway.

121b: DAX: I was!

122 SAMANTHA: We've got... various spare parts hung festively

across your branches. And... there!

123 NATALIS: What's that?

124 SAMANTHA: So I've moulded a hummingbird out of wire, foil and

a — washing up liquid bottle. So you can wear it as

a hat.

125 NATALIS: It's beautiful.

126 KILNER: Are you ready?

127 NATALIS: I'm ready.

128 DAX: I'll bring us into land now. And they're - moving out

of the way again. I don't think I'll get used to that.

129 SFX: THEY LAND. THE RAMP OPENS.

NATALIS TAKES A FEW STEPS TOWARDS IT, THEN STOPS.

130 NATALIS: Oh I'm so nervous!

131 SAMANTHA: You'll be fine. I promise.

132 NATALIS: I hope so.

132b DAX: You look lovely.

133 SAMANTHA: Deep breaths. You'll do great.

133b NATALIS: Thank you!

133c SAMANTHA: Remember, this is as much for you as it is for

everyone else there. The important thing is that you like how you look, and that you feel comfortable. You make sure you enjoy this, and if anyone else

does, that's a bonus!

134 NATALIS: Thank you.

134b: DAX: Goodbye!

137	KILNER:	I'm sure she will. Look at her. You did a really good job.

140	SAMANTHA:	Maybe. I feel like those little pots can't be practical when they get bigger
143	KILNER:	You know what? That's got me in the mood for Brucemas.
144	SAMANTHA:	Really? That's like a month away. You never normally let me put up decorations this early!
145	KILNER:	Well Maybe this year we should.
146	SAMANTHA:	Yay!
147	KILNER:	I'll go get the Brucemas Tower from the storage space.
148	SAMANTHA:	And I'll get the hoses! I picked up some new ones after last year's - uh, fire!
